The end customer using the Switchvox system

How to claim your rebate:

- Buy a Switchvox appliance with SMB software from March 1st through May 31st 2009.
- Download the Telecom Stimulus Claim Form, located at www.digium.com/stimulusclaimform
- Complete the claim form in its entirety. E-mail the claim form and a copy of the invoice to rebates@digium.com, or fax it to 256-428-6058.
- Rebate checks will be made payable to the end-user company and sent within 6 weeks from the date the claim form is approved by Digium. You will receive an e-mail when the rebate has been approved for payment.

Program Rules

- Eligible products include any Digium Switchvox appliance with SMB software and at least 20 subscriptions.
- The invoice date must be between March 1, 2009 and May 31st, 2009.
- The system must be installed and registered by June 30th, 2009.
- The Telecom Stimulus Claim Form must be filled out in its entirety and submitted to Digium no later than June 30th, 2009.
- Checks will be made payable in USD (U.S. Dollars) to the company name on the invoice and mailed to the company address designated on the claim form.

FAQ's

Is there a limit to the number of systems eligible for the rebate?

No, there is no limit.

Can a reseller claim the rebate?

No, the rebate is available only to the end customer using the system.

Do I need to buy 20 subscriptions to be eligible for the rebate?

20 subscriptions need to be part of the order. Systems purchased through resellers include 10 free subscriptions, so you would need to buy 10 more subscriptions for a total of 20 to be eligible for the rebate.

Can I mix/match support levels on the subscriptions?

No, all subscriptions must be at the same support level.

I purchased my system within the eligibility period but did not register my system until after the promotion ended. Can I still get a rebate?

Yes, as long as the form is received by Digium no later than June 30th, 2009

I purchased a system with 100 extensions. Am I eligible for a larger rebate?

No. A system that has a minimum of 20 subscriptions is only eligible for one of 3 rebates listed in the offer.

I have a free system that I upgraded to SMB. Am I eligible for a rebate?

No. Only new purchases of SMB software delivered on a Digium appliance are eligible for purchase.

Can the rebate check be issued to a company other than the one on the invoice?

No. The rebate check will be made out to the name of the company on the invoice.

Under what conditions would my purchase NOT be eligible for a rebate?

- If the claim form is not received by Digium
- If the claim form is not filled out in its entirety
- If the registration code is associated with a rebate that's already been processed
- If you are not the end customer using the equipment
- If you did not include an invoice with your claim form
- If your invoice is dated before March 1st or after May 31st, 2009
- If your claim was received after June 30th, 2009
- If your system was not registered by June 30th, 2009
- If your system has fewer than 20 subscriptions
- If your system does not have SMB software
- If your system was not purchased on a Digium appliance. The "software-only" version of SMB is not eligible.
